Transportation will only be afforded to ESY students and eligible 3rd, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students. Parents will have the option to request registration at any of the open secondary s. Students in need of grade course recovery currently in school-wide schools of choice i.e., (DASH, MAST, & New World) may attend any open co-enrollment summer site. Alternative Education – All non-disciplinary students will have the opportunity to enroll in their neighborhood school for the purpose of credit recovery and/or promotion.

Extended School Year (ESY) will be provided based on the requirements of the individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and implementing the regulations of 34 CFR 300.309, and is aligned with the summer services schedule. ESY must be considered by the Individual Plan (IEP) team as part of the provision of a free appropriate public education for students with disabilities that require services beyond the regular 180 day school year. ESY data is collected over the course of the school year to determine eligibility for ESY, which may include direct or indirect services, and related services, including transportation. Regional Centers will determine the assigned middle school location for ESY services for rising 6th grade and high school students.
