

Mobile Device Summer Checkout for High School Students

Who is Eligible for Summer Checkout?

- Senior high school students who passed Algebra 1 course, but failed the Algebra 1 End of Course (EOC) assessment
- Rising seniors who failed the ELA Florida Standards Assessment
- Students who meet the above criteria and who do not have reliable Internet access at home
 - No reliable Internet access at home is defined as having a slow Internet connection (i.e. dial up speeds) or having multiple siblings in the same household working from a single computer.

Using the Sprint Smartphones

- Students can connect their district-issued mobile devices to the phone's hotspot and access digital resources
 - Senior high school students who passed Algebra 1 course, but failed the Algebra 1 End of Course (EOC) assessment can access the online Algebra 1 EOC assessment prep modules
 - Rising seniors who failed the ELA Florida Standards Assessment will be able to access Khan Academy's online SAT prep

How do Students Get the Phones?

- Eligible students who wish to receive a Sprint smartphone need to submit a signed parent consent form prior to receiving a phone
- Students may use the phones during the summer and continue using it during their senior year in high school
